Year 6 Sculpture Project

In recent years, we have been fortunate enough to be able to arrange for our eldest pupils to create a piece of artwork to stay in school after their time with us. You will have noticed our willow sculptures that are on the Hall Road side of the site which were created in recent years by previous cohorts.

This year, our Year 6 pupils will be working with Natasha Hoseago, a local artist, to create an installation that symbolises our 'Open Hearts' vision. Natasha is a sculpture artist who works with fallen wood. It is her belief that by taking naturally fallen wood, and using it to create art, the piece is given a second life.

From Monday, Natasha will be working with the Year 6 pupils on the school field throughout her four-day residency. Parents and children are very welcome to approach Natasha at the beginning and end of the school days or during our informal Open Evening on Thursday, to see her work. A blackboard will be placed within Natasha's workspace if families would like to share their ideas about what the school vision means to them; these reflections will then be woven into the final design as the piece develops.

We hope that this piece of art will signify to all children and families that, even when pupils leave our school, they will always be part of our school family.
