Lunchtimes at Leckhampton

Now that the wintry weather is upon us, we would like to inform parents of a few changes that we are making to lunchtimes to ensure that the children continue to have engaging and active lunchtimes over the winter months.

From Monday 2nd December the following changes will be in place:

- Slight changes to timings: Reception and KS1 lunchtime will be from 11.45am to 12.45pm. Year 3 lunchtime will be from 12.30pm to 1.30pm (with Y4, Y5 & Y6).
- Old School Hall: This will be open four days a week for games, crafts & colouring, please see the timetable below for when your child can access this:

• KS2 Midday Laps: At 1pm each day, pupils in Years 3 – 6 will have an opportunity to run laps of the school field. If you would like your child to take part in this, they will need to change their school shoes for outdoor shoes (old trainers will be best) before they go to lunch. They will need to label their school shoes just in case shoes are misplaced. They need to store their muddy trainers in a labelled carrier bag on their peg until the end of each week. If Midday Laps prove successful, we will consider rolling this out to the younger children in the new year.

A few lunchtime reminders:

- Lunchboxes must be labelled on the outside of the box so that they can easily be returned to children.
- No lunchboxes should be left on the shelves after school or over the weekend please.

Spelling Update from the English Team

We wanted to say 'hello' and update you about some tweaks that we're going to make to supplement our spelling curriculum.

In the new year, we will launch the fabulous and fun platform that is 'Spelling Shed'! This is an online system to support the practising of spelling at home through interactive games and activities. Teachers will share a range of specific words through the children's 'Spelling Shed' platform to enable the children to practise at home.

In addition to this, we will also be developing the half-termly spelling letter that we send out within year groups. You'll see some small changes to the letter that will hopefully support you further when practising with your children at home.

To challenge the children in Years 3-6, we will also be holding a ten-word spelling quiz at the end of each week. This quiz will include words from the games and activities the children will have experienced, using 'Spelling Shed' and in class. These quizzes will not start until we have launched this online resource.

Login details for 'Spelling Shed' will be shared within the half-termly guidance. We plan to start using this resource in the new year...so keep your eyes peeled for further instructions!
