Mondays: Tag Rugby - Tag rugby is a fun, non-contact version of rugby, perfect for this age group. Skill development in running with the ball, passing, dodging and teamwork. **11 weeks, £60.50** for the term. 7th September – 30th November (no session 12/10 – parents evening week, 26/10 – half term).

Wednesdays: Ball Games - focus on invasion games such as netball, basketball, football and hockey. Skill development in catching, throwing, dribbling, shooting, attacking and defending. **11 weeks, £60.50** for the term. 9th September – 2nd December (no session 14/10 – parents evening week, 28/10 – half term).

Thursdays: Multi-Skills - focus on fundamental skill development which is essential in many sports. Skill development in balancing, running, jumping, hopping, catching, throwing and striking. **9 weeks, £49.50** for the term. 10th September – 3rd December (no session 1/10 – school disco, 15/10 – parents evening week, 22/10 – coach annual leave, 29/10 – half term).
